Do not prune - high sap run causes plant to die back. Take all cuttings, bud and graft now

Do not shear sheep and avoid animal surgery - high risk of gangrene

Harvest, mow lawn

Do not plant or transplant, though can plant melon seeds

Transplant and plant all plants and seedlings

Do not prune - high sap run causes plant to die back. Take all cuttings, bud and graft now

Fertile period ends

Prune - low sap run. Good time for animal surgery

Harvest crops and make hay

Cultivate

Destroy weeds and pests

Do not plant or transplant vegetables

Good for fishing!

Apply organic fertilizer. Prepare beds for fertile period, add compost, mulch, repairs, etc.

Graft and prune

Seeds planted produce vines or stalks. Plants germinated now are quick to bolt (go to seed)

Do not plant, prune, bud and graft now.

Destroy noxious growth and pests

Cultivate, plough and tilt soil

Fertile period begins

Plant and transplant, good for root growth. Assists to withstand drought. Potatoes planted now tend to sprout bud at the eye

Do not, prune - high sap run causes plant to die back. Take cuttings, bud and graft now.

Fertile period begins

Sow and plant all root crops. Poor time to transplant

Harvest

Fertile period begins

Irrigate

Can transplant tomatoes

Do not harvest root crops - potatoes may rot

Good time to prune - low sap run. Good time for animal surgery

Harvest fruit and root crops

Do not plant seed, it will rot!

Destroy unwanted growth, weeds and pests

Good time for fishing!

Apply organic fertilizer. Prepare beds for fertile period, add compost, mulch, repairs, etc.
